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### 1. STATEMENT OF INVITATION

CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd, a Mangaung Metro Municipal entity, distributing electricity in the Mangaung Metro area and other municipalities, requests proposals to research, design, install, commission, maintain and repair service of a virtual reality training simulator for Medium and High Voltage networks mimicking the networks configuration of CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd for the training of personnel for a period of thirty-six (36) months.

# 2. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 Supply unique security personal identification number (PIN) and/or original TAX Clearance Certificate for TAX compliant status.
- 2.2 Supply municipal services (water, sanitation, rates and electricity) clearance certificate or Lease Agreement with a current Bill and rates clearances, or Current Bill of Account not owing more than 30 days. The virtual reality training simulator system will be aimed at training operators to open, isolate and earth a typical Medium and High voltage network based on the CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd Standard Operating Procedures.

# 6. SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

- 6.1. The service provider shall ensure that no property (CENTLEC's or private) is damaged or misused in the execution of the task.
- 6.1 The successful bidder will be expected to enter into Service Level Agreement (SLA) with CENTLEC for a period of thirty-six (36) months.
- 6.2. The successful service provider shall have public liability insurance to cover any liability claims from the public.
- 6.3. The service provider must train CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd Training and Development employees on the use of the virtual reality training simulator during the duration of this contract. (Transfer of skills)
- 6.4. The Bidder must be a South Africa based company with all the necessary facilities to repair the complete virtual reality training simulator and related equipment. Compile a complete profile and submit it. (**Profile of company**)
- 6.5. The successful bidder shall ensure that his employees are properly informed and trained to perform the task. Submit a letter of commitment for training of CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd personnel for the whole term of contract. All his employees must be vetted for security purposes.
- 6.6. The bidder shall ensure that all tasks are performed in line with applicable legislation, e.g. OHS ACT, Construction Regulations, Labour Act, Electricity Amendment Act, Electricity Supply Regulations, the Mangaung Metro Municipality By-laws relating to electricity supply and the Standard operating procedures of CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd.
- 6.7. The successful bidder shall conduct a risk assessment of the work to be performed and must ensure that spares on the virtual reality training simulator equipment are available within two (2) weeks after receiving an order.
- 6.8. The successful bidder will be required to submit a Health and Safety file before commencing with duties. The Health and Safety file will have to meet the CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd standard that forms part of this specification and it will have to be submitted within two weeks of receiving the appointment letter.
- 6.9. The successful bidder shall inform CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd of any sub-contractor they employed during the duration of the contract and shall ensure that the Health and Safety file of the sub-contractor is updated accordingly.

- 6.10 The successful bidder is required to provide a minimum of one (1) year guarantee on all the equipment supply and workmanship.
- 6.11 The successful bidder will be required to provide repair and maintenance service for the duration of the contract.
- 6.12 The successful bidder must be available for assistance with any emergency support and repairs on software and hardware within 48 hours
- 6.13 The following must be provided after installation:
  - i. As built drawings.
  - ii. Training a minimum 5 days must be incorporate in the cost to training staff and system administrator in terms of the system setup and operation.
- 6.14 The simulator must be installed at the CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd. Training and Development Centre at 30 Rhodes Avenue, Oranjesig, Bloemfontein, 9301.

# 7. EVALUATION CRITERIA

All proposals submitted will be evaluated in accordance with the criteria set out in the policy of Supply Chain Management of the Entity.

The most suitable candidate will then be selected. Please take note that CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd is not bound to select any of the firms submitting proposals. CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd furthermore reserves the right to select more than one bidder.

Furthermore, technical competence is the principal selection criteria, CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd will evaluate the technical criteria first, and will only look at the price and BBBEE level of contribution if it is satisfied with the technical evaluation. As a result of this, CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd does not bind itself in **any** way to select the firm offering the lowest price.


