OUTREACH PROGRAMME AT BOTSHABELO

Botshabelo is one of the areas that is affected by socio-economic factors within the bigger Mangaung Metropolitan area. It is faced with problems relating to illegal connections, tampering of meters that have significantly increased over the



years.

On the 28th of June 2015, CENTLEC (SOC) Ltd was invited by the United Reformed Church of South Africa, Botshabelo West to share information and educate their members on how to save electricity, deal with issues relating to copper theft, tampering of meters, load shedding and learnership opportunities that are available.

The community strongly believed that a lot has to be done in the Botshabelo area as there are so many electricity related problems that sometimes cause unnecessary power failures. The connection and distribution of electricity from a meter box at other households is still a challenge.

"Certain community members still use wires not suitable for the purpose of wiring which often result in unnecessary explosions, accidents and even deaths because these wires cannot handle the heat", says one of the community member. Through these campaigns, we will continue as an institution to empower our people with meaningful information so that they are able to use electricity effectively and safely.


