ELECTRICITY TARIFFS FOR THE PERIOD 01 JULY 2023 - 30 JUNE 2024

The Energy Regulator at its meeting held on the 02 June 2023 approved the guideline increase of 15,1% for municipalities applicable for the 2023/24 financial year. Consequently, the Energy Regulator considered your application for a tariff increase for the period 1 July 2023 – 30 June 2024 and approved the tariffs as follows:

The Energy Regulator further directs that the licensee's administrator should ensure that the areas of concern noted in the electricity department are adequately addressed in its turnaround strategies developed; this includes adequate provision for maintenance, energy losses mitigation and implementation of revenue management/debt recovery strategies. The licensee should work closely with NERSA in this regard and report quarterly as of 20 September 2023.

The Energy Regulator further directs that the licensee increase its expenditure on Repairs and Maintenance to NERSA benchmarks of 6% to ensure that its electricity network is efficient and sustainable

Please note that in terms of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004), the National Energy Regulator is entrusted to perform all the functions that the National Electricity Regulator used to perform, and amongst others, to review and approve tariff increase proposals by all licensed distributors of electricity in South Africa. Implementation of tariffs without approval of the Energy Regulator is a contravention of the license conditions issued to you.

It is therefore important that provision is made in your planning / budgeting cycle to allow time for the submission of applications for future changes or increases to NERSA for consideration.
